IAGS 2011 Exhibition Information

The exhibition will be open Mon-Fri 22-26 August 2011 at the University of Lapland (address: Yliopistonkatu 8, Rovaniemi, Finland). For details about the congress and exhibition timetable see the schedule below.

The price for exhibition stands at the IAGS 2011 is **500 €/ m²**

The smallest exhibition stand covers 4 m² (2 x 2 m). Exhibition stands will be reserved on a first come – first served basis. Stand locations are shown in the attached floor plan. The size of each lot in square metres is marked on the floor plan. You are welcome to reserve bigger stands up to the whole lot. In case of overbooking and/or tiny leftover sites the organizers will negotiate with exhibitors for maximal usage of the space and maximal satisfaction of the exhibitors. We reserve the right to refuse the space reservation if the company's products do not directly contribute to the professional practice of the attendants.

The price of the 4 m² exhibition stand includes

- the reserved floor space
- one table and two chairs / 4 m²
- white back wall panels (width 2 x 100 cm, height 250 cm), no side wall panels
- one electrical outlet (230 V 50 Hz, max. 500 W per site)
- one full participation in the conference / 4 m²
- company name/logo on the IAGS 2011 webpage
- company listing in the final conference programme

The registration fee for extra exhibitors is the normal conference registration fee. All exhibitors, including the one included in the exhibition rent, must register for the conference in advance using the conference registration form.

The exhibitor is responsible for setting up and fitting out its own stand. No material is allowed to be fixed on walls. There is a locked storage room reserved for exhibitors. The exhibition venue will be closed at night times and under electronic access control.

Electricity and electrical installation, data connection

The organizers are responsible for the general lighting of the exhibition area. The main electricity supply is 230V. One electrical outlet / 4 m² is included in the stand price. A free wireless access to Internet is available in the exhibition area (username and password will be provided by the conference office).

Security and insurance

The organizer is responsible for fire safety and general order in the exhibition area. The organizer shall not be held liable for any damage to or the disappearance of goods, structures or other materials. The exhibitor must independently take out any insurance policy that it regards as warranted. The insurance policies held by the organizers cover any possible damage caused by the actions of the organizers' employees or by any of their equipment or constructions.
