



Instructions for IAGS 2011 poster presenters

The programme with abstracts and session information will be added on the conference website **by 15 June 2011**.

The posters will be on display during the whole conference. Your poster should be mounted on Monday as soon as you arrive at the conference venue, by noon at the latest. You can remove your poster after lunch break on Friday. There will not be a separate poster session.

The poster size is A0 (840 x 1190 mm).

Equipment supplied

Poster boards with a maximum width of 90 cm and a height of 120 cm.

Posters will be attached with tape (pushpins cannot be used).

The IAGS 2011 organizers would like to remind you of a few key points:

- Make your poster visually interesting, but not over-elaborate
- Your poster should follow an easy to understand format i.e. abstract methods, results and conclusions
- Posters may be prepared on one sheet (preferred method) or alternatively on several smaller sheets.
- Please check the more detailed instructions below

DO'S

- DO indicate at the top of your poster the abstract number, title of the presentation and its authors and institutions. The lettering for this sign should be at least 2.5 cm high
- DO use block lettering (at least 1.25 cm high) for other portions of your presentation to add emphasis and readability
- Keep illustrative material simple by using charts, graphs, drawings and pictures. Keep in mind that your illustrations must be read from a distance of about 1–1.5m or more.
- DO use matte (silk) finish for photographs as this will help diminish glare
- DO make posters as self-explanatory as possible
- DO provide descriptive handouts if useful to attendees

DONT'S

- DO NOT mount abstracts on heavy board, thus avoiding hanging problems
- DO NOT use projection equipment (projectors are not supplied)
- DO NOT write or paint on the poster board as background for your poster (someone will be using the poster board after you)
